The donation was delivered to the food bank at the Wilmore Presbyterian Church on December 6, 2018. The family also participated in a service event on December 22.

The Community Service Center’s mission is to identify needs within the communities, to organize resources, and to develop programs to address those needs through their Thrift Shop and Needs Assistance program.

The Thrift Shop offers a large selection of clothing, books, household items and small furniture items for sale at reduced prices. Proceeds from the Thrift Shop help support the Needs Assistance program, which offers assistance with utility payments (water, gas or electric), housing and rental payments, clothing (related to fire, flood, unexpected relocation), food pantry, and limited counsel on accessing other resources within Wilmore, Jessamine County or the Lexington area.

Billie Jo and Brett Setzer, along with their five daughters, are long-time residents and supporters of Jessamine County.
