

Brett Construction Company & Employees Continue Season of Giving

Lexington, KY – Brett Construction Company and the company's employees continue their season of giving this holiday season by helping those in need through multiple service organizations in the Central Kentucky region. Their contributions include donating non-perishable food items to food drives, adopting women and children from local service organizations, and making a donation to a coat drive through a local non-profit organization.

"Our company is a family" said Brett Setzer, CEO of Brett Construction Company. "All of us enjoy coming together and finding ways, whether it's donating food or buying new coats or adopting entire families, to do all that we can to help others have an enjoyable holiday season with their families."

The company recently donated **600 cans of non-perishable food items** to the food pantry at the Community Service Center of Wilmore and High Bridge in Jessamine County, a non-profit organization established in 1985. The Community Service Center provides clothing to families in need, as well as budgeting and emergency financial assistance, including assistance with utilities, food, shelter, household goods and clothing. Brett and Billie Jo Setzer, along with their five daughters, are long-time residents and supporters of Jessamine County.

Brett Construction Company also adopted **three women and their children** from The Well of Lexington, a non-profit organization committed to helping women live free from sexual exploitation, addiction and homelessness. Women who enter the program live in a supportive community for two years, working with a licensed professional case manager, receiving all the services needed to heal from past trauma, to improve education, and to address physical and emotional health.

The company also adopted a **mother and her three children** from the Children's Advocacy Network of the Bluegrass, a non-profit organization established in 1994 and dedicated to reducing the trauma experienced by child victims of sexual abuse within the 17-county Bluegrass region. Services include coordination of agencies during investigation and prosecution, providing education to professionals and the public, and providing therapeutic support and victim assistance. All services are provided at no cost to children and their non-offending families.

In addition, Brett Construction Company previously donated **\$500, the equivalent of 33 youth coats**, to Believing in Forever's sixth annual "A Coat to Keep the Cold Away" drive benefiting local youth on December 9th of this year. Believing in Forever is a 501(c)3 non-profit established by Devine Carama, a local indie hip-hop artist. The organization's mission is to inspire and motivate young people towards community leadership through art, education, mentoring and community service.

The company also hosted a food drive and employees donated **500 pounds of food** for God's Pantry Food Bank on November 20th of this year. God's Pantry seeks to reduce hunger in Kentucky through community cooperation, making the best possible use of all available resources. God's Pantry is part of both Feeding America and Feeding Kentucky, networks that work together to more effectively meet the needs of serving the state and the nation.
