Brett Construction Completes Meadowthorpe Landing, a New Affordable Senior Housing Facility in Lexington

Lexington, KY – On Monday, August 10, Lexington Mayor Linda Gorton, along with Councilmember Josh McCurn and representatives from the entire development team, held a ribbon-cutting ceremony to officially open the new 71-unit Meadowthorpe Landing complex at 1447 Antique Drive in Lexington, Kentucky. The project offers 57 one-bedroom and 14 two-bedroom apartments in the affordable senior housing market.

Meadowthorpe Landing was a partnership between the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government's Affordable Housing Fund, Kentucky Housing Corporation, Community Affordable Housing Equity Corporation, Berkadia, Freddie Mac and RiverHills Bank. The project was developed by AU Associates, designed by architecture firm Lord Aeck Sargent, and built by Lexington-based Brett Construction Company.
